GUAM CONSOLIDATED COMMISSION ON UTILITIES RESOLUTION NO. 02–FY2017

RELATIVE TO APPROVAL OF THE CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT (CM) CONTRACT FOR BAZA GARDENS WASTEWATER CROSS-ISLAND PUMPING AND CONVEYANCE SYSTEM PROJECT

WHEREAS, under 12 G.C.A. § 14105, the Consolidated Commission on Utilities ("CCU") has plenary authority over financial, contractual, and policy matters relative to the Guam Waterworks Authority ("GWA"); and

WHEREAS, the Guam Waterworks Authority ("GWA") is a Guam Public Corporation established and existing under the laws of Guam; and

WHEREAS, GWA currently has a number of critical Court Order ("CO") projects including a complete evaluation of the Baza Gardens WWTP to determine what improvements are necessary at the plant to achieve compliance with the WWTP's NDPES permit, as stated in Paragraph 13 of the 2011 Court Order as well as the completion of construction activities that were identified in the approved plan resulting from the evaluation noted above as stated in Paragraph 14 of the 2011 Court Order; and

WHEREAS, the system evaluation report required under Paragraph 13 and completed in April of 2014 by GWA's Program Management Office (PMO), Brown and Caldwell, resulted in a recommendation to GWA and the USEPA that transferring/conveying the Baza Gardens WWTP effluent flow across the Route 17 (Cross Island Road) to a new Agat-Santa Rita WWTP site was the recommended conceptual alternative to which this recommendation was found to be acceptable by all parties; and

WHEREAS, Paragraph 14, subsection (b) of the 2011 Court Order required that GWA "execute a contract and issue a notice to proceed with construction" by October 31, 2016; and

WHEREAS, in September of 2015 GWA began the procurement process to find a consulting engineering team to design the wastewater conveyance system and via Resolution 06-FY2016, approved by the CCU in October of 2015, GWA management was authorized to enter

into a contract with Duenas Camacho and Associates to design the wastewater conveyance and pumping system which would include new Sewer Pump Station (SPS), gravity mains, force mains and all incidentals and appurtenances to these man components; and

WHEREAS, GWA has determined that in an effort to comply with the intent of the Court Order Paragraph 14(b) deadline of October 31, 2016 the most expedient process was to break the construction activities into four phases with the first phase covering the construction of one sewer pump station located by the Aplacho Bridge, 14,643 linear feet of gravity sewer and 2,767 linear feet of force main which is considered approximately one-third of the overall project requirements; and

WHEREAS, there are other factors that come into play relative to the decision of phasing the project, such as construction funding availability that is tied to bond borrowing as well as overcoming property acquisition issues but wherein GWA anticipates procurement of the construction services for each phase noted within a three months of each other and with the expectation that all phase of the construction project will be completed by April 30, 2018; and

WHEREAS, Construction of Phase II, III & IV is the conversion of the existing Baza Gardens WWTP site to a pretreatment facility that includes headworks (screening and grit removal), Equalization Tanks 1 & 2, Baza Gardens Pump Station, Operations structures, along with Pump Station 2 near Windward Hills Country Club and laying of force main and gravity sewer lines along Route 17; and

WHEREAS, the installation of the new wastewater conveyance/pumping system along Route 17 and the improvement of Baza Gardens Wastewater Treatment Plant requires qualified and experienced engineering/construction management services to oversee all aspects of the construction project that entails a some specialty construction trades, construction activities that can run simultaneously and at multiple locations, and construction costs that may reach Twenty Nine Million Dollars (\$29,000,000.00) for all four phases; and

WHEREAS, GWA has determined that having one construction management team to oversee all construction phases will allow for better construction oversight and control thus is in the best interest of GWA and the rate payers; and

WHEREAS, GWA has advertised the Request for Proposal (RFP-09-ENG-2016) soliciting a statement of qualification from experienced and qualified engineering firms to provide construction management services for the Baza Gardens Wastewater Cross-Island Pumping and Conveyance System Project; and

WHEREAS, Request for Proposal (RFP) packages were downloaded by multiple interested parties, from which GWA received proposals submitted by seven (7) engineering firms before the RFP submittal deadline; and

WHEREAS, the GWA A-E Selection Committee reviewed and evaluated the seven (7) proposals (see EXHIBIT A - Evaluation Scores) and generated a short list of the top three (3) firms with a recommendation to award a contract to the firm SSFM International, (see EXHIBIT B – GM Determination); and

WHEREAS, SSFM International and GWA are currently in the process of negotiating the scope and a reasonable fee for the CM services and expect to come to a conclusion within a week or two; and

WHEREAS, GWA's expectation for construction management service fees with an estimated construction cost of the amount noted, as well as the complexity of the work described, would be in the six to nine percent (6% - 9%) range therefore GWA could expect the estimated high end of the CM serves to be Two Million Six Hundred Ten Thousand Dollars (\$2,610,000.00); and

WHEREAS, the on-going procurement for construction management services is necessary to align, as best as possible, the timing of GWA's issuance of the Notice to Proceed for the construction contract by October 31, 2016, with the start of CM services and as such GWA management is seeking the support by the CCU to approve the need and intent of the

construction management services and the estimated high end of the CM range cost of Two Million Six Hundred Ten Thousand Dollars (\$2,610,000.00) in advance of the fee negotiations phase; and

WHEREAS, GWA Management further seeks CCU approval of a ten percent (10%) contingency to the final negotiated CM fee amount in which the contingency could be as high as Two Hundred Sixty One Thousand Dollars (\$261,000.00); and

WHEREAS, GWA management will provide an update via the GM's Report the results of the procurement process relative to this resolution which will include the final negotiated CM fees; and

WHEREAS, funding for this project will be from 2016 Bond Funds under the CIP line item WW 11-03 "Baza Gardens STP Replacement"; and

NOW BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, the Consolidated Commission on Utilities does hereby approve the following:

- 1. The recitals set forth above hereby constitute the findings of the CCU.
- 2. The CCU finds that the terms of the conditions set by GWA relative to commencement of work activities are fair and reasonable and serve as a measure of Quality Assurance/Quality Control (QA/QC).
- 3. The CCU hereby approves the intent of the project and authorizes GWA management to enter into a contract with SSFM International (Exhibits A and B), should fee negotiations meet GWA's expectation that the fee not exceed Two Million Six Hundred Ten Thousand Dollars (\$2,610,000.00).
- 4. The CCU hereby further approves the total funding amount for this project shall not exceed a contract amount of Two Million Six Hundred Ten Thousand Dollars (\$2,610,000.00), plus a ten percent (10%) contingency of Two Hundred Sixty One Thousand Dollars (\$261,000.00), for a total authorized amount of Two Million Eight Hundred Seventy One Thousand Dollars (\$2,871,000.00).

 The CCU hereby further approves that the funding for the construction management services will be from 2016 Bond Funds under the line item CIP WW 11-03 Baza Gardens STP Replacement.

RESOLVED, that the Chairman certified and the Board Secretary attests to the adoption of this Resolution.
