## RESOLUTION NO. 2016-19

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3           **CONSOLIDATED COMMISSION ON UTILITIES APPROVAL OF THE SOLAR ENERGY PURCHASE**  
4           **AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE GUAM EDUCATION FINANCING FOUNDATION (GEFF) AND THE**  
5           **GUAM DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION (GDOE)**  
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7           **WHEREAS**, the Guam Department of Education has requested that the Consolidated  
8 Commission on Utilities (CCU) review and approve the Solar Purchase Agreement between the Guam  
9 Education Financing Foundation (GEFF) and the Guam Department of Education (GDOE) as provided by  
10 Public Law 32-095 (11/27/13); and

11           **WHEREAS**, Guam Power Authority (GPA) has reviewed the proposed agreement, and the solar  
12 PV system proposed by GEFF meets the requirements set forth in PL 32-095 in that the system must not  
13 exceed 80% of the power used by the school, and not to exceed 80% of GPA billing; and

14           **WHEREAS**, the proposed agreement provides for solar PV systems for Okkodo High School,  
15 Astumbo Middle School, Liguán Elementary School, and Adacao Elementary School; and

16           **WHEREAS**, GPA will require that the proposed solar PV system be reviewed by a system impact  
17 study to determine what mitigation measures may be required by the installation of the proposed solar  
18 PV systems at the four schools.

19           **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the CONSOLIDATED COMMISSION ON UTILITIES as  
20 follows:

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- 22           1.       The proposed Solar Purchase Agreement between the Guam Education Financing  
23                   Foundation (GEFF) and the Guam Department of Education (GDOE) as attached is  
24                   approved, subject to the completion of a system impact study for the four school  
25                   locations, and the installation of any mitigation measures recommended by GPA as a  
26                   result of the system impact study, which shall be done at the expense of GEFF.
  - 27           2.       The Contract price for the first year of commercial operation is set at no greater than  
28                   \$0.196/KWH.  
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1           **RESOLVED**, that the Chairman of the Commission certifies and the Secretary of the Commission  
2 attests the adoption of this Resolution




