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RESOLUTION NO. 2017-20

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AUTHORIZING MANAGEMENT OF THE GUAM POWER AUTHORITY TO AWARD THE CONTRACT FOR ENGINEERING AND TECHNICAL SERVICES TO SUPPORT GPA'S RESOURCE PLANS (RFP-17-002) TO LEIDOS, INC.

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WHEREAS, the most recent IRP recommended the conversion from RFO to ULSD or LNG and the continued use of Piti #7, #8 and #9; and

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WHEREAS, GPA's Energy Conversion Agreements for Piti #7 and Piti #8 and 9 are expiring within the next two years and ownership will transfer to GPA; and

12 13 WHEREAS, transition to ULSD will require assessment of current resources, construction and installation of new facilities, or modification of current facilities to retrofit them for ULSD usage; and

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WHEREAS, to ensure proper transition of ownership and continued reliability, efficiency and availability of the power plants after the Energy Conversion Agreement period, adequate planning and assessment are needed; and

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WHEREAS, in preparation for these tasks, GPA solicited the services of a firm or consortium of firms to provide Engineering and Technical Services supporting Resource Plans (RFP-17-002), through Resolution 2016-58 and PUC Docket 1705; and

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WHEREAS, LEIDOS, Inc. was determined to be the most qualified proponent (Exhibit A);

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WHEREAS, approval is requested to allow the General Manager to award the contract to Leidos, Inc. for task orders not exceeding \$1,000,000.00 in 2017-2018.

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NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the CONSOLIDATED COMMISSION ON UTILITIES subject to the review and approval of the Public Utilities Commission as follows:

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- The General Manager is authorized to proceed with the award of RFP-17-002 for Engineering and Technical Services to Support GPA's Resource Plans to LEIDOS, Inc.
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- 2. The General Manager is authorized an increase in contracting authority on this contract to \$1,000,000.00.
