WHEREAS, GPA's evaluation committee recommended the award of the RFP GPA-036-17 to Pacific Data Systems; and

WHEREAS, Pacific Data Systems offers met the requirements of GPA's specifications and the amount offered of \$317,110.63 9 (Exhibit A) has been determined to be fair and reasonable; and

WHEREAS, the cost for the application software with 1,000 users includes Active-Active state, which is defined as 2 applications running concurrently to ensure redundancy and resiliency, and
