GPA RESOLUTION NO. 2020-13 1 2 RELATIVE TO AUTHORIZING THE AWARD OF A PERFORMANCE MANAGEMENT CONTRACT 3 FOR GPA'S CABRAS UNITS #1 AND #2 STEAM TURBINE POWER PLANT 4 TO TAIWAN ELECTRICAL AND MECHANICAL ENGINEERING SERVICES (TEMES, INC.) 5 6 WHEREAS, the Guam Power Authority (GPA) had a five-year Performance Management 7 Contract (PMC) for the Management, Operation and Maintenance of the Cabras 1&2 Steam 8 Turbine Power Plant awarded to TEMES, that commenced in October 2010; and 9 WHEREAS, the PMC awarded to TEMES expired on Sept. 30, 2015 through Resolution 10 2015-35 and was approved for extension up to December 31, 2015; and 11 WHEREAS, the PMC was subsequently approved for another extension through 12 December 30, 2016 through Resolution 2015-62A; and 13 WHEREAS, through CCU Resolution 2016-62, the Authority was approved to extend the 14 Cabras 1&2 PMC Contract for another three years and nine months, up to September 30, 2020; 15 including an optional extension year up to 2021; and 16 WHEREAS, through PUC Docket 17-09, the Authority was approved to extend the Cabras 17 1&2 PMC Contract for only another three years and nine months, up to September 30, 2020; 18 and 19 WHEREAS, GPA's Phase II Renewable Resource Acquisition contracts are expected to 20 start commercial operation by 3rd quarter of 2022; and 21 WHEREAS, GPA's new power plant was awarded in November 2019, and is expected to 22 be placed in commercial operation at the end of 2022, if not delayed; and 23 WHEREAS, in order to ensure adequate capacity to meet the Megawatt demands of the 24 island, the Cabras 1&2 Steam Turbine Power Plant must continue to be operated and 25 maintained until the new power plant is commissioned; and 26 WHEREAS, GPA issued a multi-step bid (IFB GPA-035-20) for a new Performance 27 Management Contract for the continued Management, Operation and Maintenance of the 28 Cabras 1&2 Steam Turbine Power Plant, and also to plan for and conduct activities related to 29 the power plant's de-activation and/or decommissioning; and 30

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2	WHEREAS, Taiwan Electrical and Mechanical Engineering Services (TEMES, INC.) was the
3	sole qualified and responsive bidder; and
4	WHEREAS, the total cost for the 3-year Base Period of the Contract Period, which is the
5	sum of Annual Management Fees proposed by TEMES, INC. and O&M Budget provided by GPA
6	is \$9,969,188.00 excluding costs for inventory, critical repairs, CIPs and
7	deactivation/decommissioning activities is reasonable.
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9	NOW, BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, by the Consolidated Commission on Utilities as the
10	governing body of GPA. and subject to the review and approval of the Public Utilities
11	Commission, does hereby approve the following:
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13	1. GPA's request to award a Performance Management Contract for GPA's Cabras
14	Units #1 and #2 Steam Turbine Power Plant to TEMES, INC.
15	2. The award of \$5,919,188.00 in Annual Management Fees, and \$4,050,000.00 in
16	O&M Budget, for a total of \$9,969,188.00 total contract amount for the base period
17	starting October 1, 2020 through September 30, 2023. These fees are excluding
18	costs for inventory, critical repairs, CIPs, and deactivation/decommissioning
19	activities.
