FY2022-03 1 2 RELATIVE TO AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE TO PROCUREE THREE (3) NEW BUCKET TRUCKS 3 FOR THE AUTHORITY'S TRANSMISSION AND DISTRIBUTION OPERATIONS 4 5 WHEREAS, GPA is committed to providing economically sound and reliable vehicles and 6 equipment to service the island's power system; and 7 WHEREAS, the Authority is in need of new 65-foot Bucket Trucks to provide the 8 9 Authority's Transmission & Distribution personnel the capability and capacity to perform new installations to support customer growth and to repair and maintain the power system in a safe 10 and efficient manner; and 11 WHEREAS, the Procurement Office has provided adequate public announcement to 12 procure three new 65-Foot Bucket Trucks through IFB GPA-048-021 providing the specifications 13 and the information required of each Offeror; and 14 WHEREAS, Morrico Equipment LLC and Far East Equipment Company LLC submitted bids 15 for GPA's consideration; and 16 WHEREAS, the GPA Evaluation Committee determined Morrico Equipment LLC to be the 17 only responsive bidder with a total cost of \$1,044,000; and 18 WHEREAS, GPA has secured CCU and PUC approval under Revenue General Plant Capital 19 Improvement Funds to procure these bucket trucks. 20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Consolidated Commission on Utilities as 21 follows: 22 After careful consideration, the Consolidated Commission on Utilities finds the 1. 23 purchase of the Bucket Trucks to be reasonable, prudent and necessary. 24 2. The General Manager of the Guam Power Authority is hereby authorized an increase 25 in obligating authority up to \$1,044,000 for the purpose of procuring three 65-Foot 26 Bucket Trucks from Morrico Equipment LLC. 27
