- 1. Supported GWA's Response and Recovery efforts for water and wastewater systems from Typhoon Mawar within approximately 4 weeks.
- 2. Completion of PUC Adjudication Process for the **FY2024 True-up** proceeding of GWA's 5-Yr Financial Plan and CIP (FY2020-FY2024)
 - a. Supported preparation of True-up submittal, petition and attendant documentation
 - b. Participated in the preparation of rebuttals to PUC Consultants and ALJ Report advocating for relief below what was requested (notably, the 16% recommended was a drastic change from their prior position of "zero" rate increases required).
 - c. Conducted presentation at PUC Rate Case Hearing in September 2023
